RESOLUTION #1-2001

WHEREAS, The City of Dry Ridge is transferring all eligible employees in the Fire Department from general coverage in the County Employees Retirement System to hazardous coverage for those hazardous duty positions within the same County Employees Retirement System, effective September 1, 2001.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by The City of Dry Ridge as follows:

- (A) That effective September 1, 2001, all employees working under hazardous duty job classifications of the Fire department will transfer from the existing nonhazardous (general) coverage in the County Employees Retirement System to hazardous duty coverage within the same County Employees Retirement System.
- (B) Contributions to be paid are as follows:
 - (1) 16.78% (current rate) of employees gross wages to be paid by the employer (may be changed by the Board of Trustees of the Kentucky Retirement Systems).
 - (2) 8% (current rate) of employee's gross wages to be paid by the employee (may be changed by the Kentucky General Assembly).

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Dry Ridge will comply with all the statutory requirements to make the County Employees Retirement System hazardous duty coverage available for all eligible employees who are working under approved positions within the Fire Department.
