

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE DRY RIDGE WATERWORKS COMMISSION EXPRESSLY REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 144 WHICH ORDINANCE CREATED THE WATERWORKS COMMISSION AND ORDINANCES NUMBERED 152, 196, and 235, WHICH ORDINANCES PERIODICALLY CHANGED THE FUNCTIONS OF THE WATERWORKS COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, prior city councils created a Dry Ridge Waterworks Commission in ordinance number 144 enacted on the 1st day of April, 1952, which ordinance was amended subsequently by ordinance number 152 enacted on the 7th day of April, 1953, further amended by ordinance number 196 enacted on the 7th day of March, 1961, and further amended by ordinance number 235 enacted on the 1st day of March, 1966, and

WHEREAS, all outstanding debts upon the Dry Ridge water distribution system have been extinguished, and

WHEREAS, the accounting firm of Kohlhepp, Von Lehman & Hofacre at the conclusion of its 1976 audit recommended the abolition of the Commission to effect cost savings for the benefit of the citizens of Dry Ridge, and

WHEREAS, the City of Dry Ridge has heretofore enacted a cost accounting system coupled with its budgetary process enabling the City to implement its accountant's suggestion,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

Ordinances numbered 144, 152, 196, and 235 enacted by prior Dry Ridge City Councils are hereby repealed.

SECTION II

The Dry Ridge Waterworks Commission is hereby abolished.


SECTION III

The Dry Ridge City Council shall henceforth by appropriate resolutions and ordinances, manage, maintain, and operate the water distribution system of the City of Dry Ridge.
