

RESOLUTION NO. 311, 1977

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
DRY RIDGE, GRANTING TO THE BULLOCK PEN WATER  
DISTRICT THE RIGHT TO INSTALL A TRUNK SERVICE  
WATER LINE WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF  
DRY RIDGE


WHEREAS, the Bullock Pen Water District has negotiated an easement  
across the property commonly known as the Stephenson Farm, lying immediately  
adjacent to the existing eastern boundary of the City of Dry Ridge, and

WHEREAS, the route agreed upon between the property owner and the Bullock  
Pen Water District is located at or near the existing City Limits of the  
City of Dry Ridge,


NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge does resolve  
as follows:

1. That the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge does hereby grant  
unto the Bullock Pen Water District, its successors and assigns,  
a perpetual right to maintain said trunk service line within the  
corporate limits of the City of Dry Ridge.
2. By the granting of this perpetual right to the Bullock Pen Water  
District the City of Dry Ridge shall assume no liability whatsoever  
for the existance of said line within its corporate boundaries.
