## ORDINANCE NUMBER 316 - 1978 CURFEW ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, it is the obligation of the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge to provide for public welfare and promote domestic transquility, and

WHEREAS, various juveniles and other persons not engaged in productive activity have been congregating on various streets of the City at late hours of the night and creating general disturbances, harrassing the citizens of the community and disturbing the public peace, and

WHEREAS, the City has been plagued with many prowlers, petty thieves, and other crimes.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) After the hour of 12:00 P.M., Eastern Standard Time, no persons shall participate in any group of persons loitering on the streets or other public places of the City of Dry Ridge,
- (2) No persons shall frequent the streets or other public places of the City of Dry Ridge after the hour of 12:00 P.M., Eastern Standard Time, except for the purpose of engaging in lawful labors or recreation or other social activities or in going to and from such lawful labors or recreational or social activities,
- (3) No persons less than Eighteen (18) years of age shall be on the public streets or other public places in the City of Dry Ridge unless accompanied by an adult person responsible for his activities or conduct after the hour of 12:00 P.M., Eastern Standard Time,
- (4) No parent, guardian or other person responsible for the care and supervision of a person less than Eighteen (18) years of age shall permit such person to be on the streets or other public places of the City of Dry Ridge during the hours from 12:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M., Eastern Standard Time, unless such person be accompanied by an adult responsible for his conduct or behavior.

Any person violating any of the provisions of Section (1), (2), (3), or (4) of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or imprisoned in the public jail for not less than One (1) nor more than Ten (10) days or both as a Court may adjudge.

Each section of this ordinance shall be separate and severable and should any section be adjudged invalid then the remaining sections shall continue in full force and effect.
