# ORDINANCE NUMBER 319 -1978

THE "FIRST ORDINANCE" PURSUANT TO KRS 107.030 AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION AND FINANCING OF THE SURFACING OF NEW DEL DRIVE FROM KENTUCKY HIGHWAY 22 SOUTH, INCLUDING THE CUL-DE-SAC.

WHEREAS requests have been submitted to the City Council by owners of property fronting on New Del Drive requesting that street be surfaced,

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

## SECTION ONE

The City proposes to surface New Del Drive, and has obtained a preliminary cost estimate from its engineering firm, Proctor, Davis, Ray Consulting Engineers, Inc. as follows: blacktop, \$23,000.00; concrete, 4 inch \$22,800.00; concrete, 6 inch, \$27,572.00.

No City funds will be expended. Bonds may be sold to finance the improvement.

### SECTION TWO

The scope of the project is as follows: to surface New Del Drive eighteen (18) feet wide from Kentucky Highway 22 south a distance of nine hundred thirty-five (935) feet to a forty (40) foot cul-de-sac, including the forty (40) foot culde-sac, blacktop or concrete according to specifications.

### SECTION THREE

The property owners to be benefited are: Charles Sidebottom, Calvin King, Clayton Martin, Glen Perkins, L. G. Wilson, Kirtley Bennett, Gary Brock, Charles Edmondson, Bill Pelfrey, Willard R. Furnish, and Wilbur R. Stith.

#### SECTION FOUR

A public hearing will be held at the City Building, 31 Broadway, on Monday, August 21, 1978, at 7:30 o'clock P.M. prevailing time, at which time and place all property owners to be benefited may appear and be heard as to:

- 1. Whether the proposed project should be undertaken or abandoned;
- 2. Whether the nature and scope of the project shall be altered;

- 3. Whether the project shall be financed through the issuance of bonds according to the assessed value basis or;
- 4. Whether the project shall be financed through assessments made and apportioned on a front-foot basis.
