ORDINANCE NUMBER 330 - 1979

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1980, AND MAKING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH

The Mayor of the City of Dry Ridge submitted to the City

Council of said City at a regular continued meeting held on July

10, 1979, a proposed budget for the fiscal year 1980. The Council

is of the opinion that such budget is sound.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I
