

RESOLUTION NO. 357-1980

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF Dry Ridge RELATING TO THE CREATION OF A LOCAL HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the United States Constitution and the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky set forth democratic principles which prohibit discrimination against persons because of race, color, sex, religion or national origin in connection with real estate transactions; and

WHEREAS, such discrimination results in harmful economic and social effects to this community; and

WHEREAS, Kentucky Revised Statutes 344.310-344.385 provides for the creation of a Local Human Rights Commission to safeguard the citizens of Dry Ridge from discrimination in real estate transactions.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge :

Section 1.

That the City of Dry Ridge establishes a Local Human Rights Commission which shall consist of five (5) members appointed on a non-partisan basis by the Mayor, subject to the approval of the Council of the City of

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following citizens be appointed to the Dry Ridge Human Rights Commission: Jane Spears for a one (1) year term; Ruth Melton and John Eckler for two (2) year terms; and Janet Bowen and Norma Hedges for three (3) year terms.
