AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT FOR VEHICLES ON STREETS MAINTAINED BY THE CITY

WHEREAS the City wishes to maintain safety on its city streets.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Dry Ridge, Commonwealth of Kentucky:

SECTION ONE

No person shall operate a motor vehicle on any street in the corporate limits of the City of Dry Ridge which is maintained solely by the City at a speed greater than TWENTY FIVE MILES PER HOUR (25 M.P.H.), unless otherwise ordained and posted.

SECTION TWO

The fine for violation of this Ordinance shall be the same as those fines imposed by KRS 189.394.

SECTION THREE

There exists the opportunity to apply for State Funding to pay for re-signing parts of Dry Ridge, to be eligible the speed limit on City maintained streets must be as above ordained, therefore an emergency exists in that funding applications must be filed before June 1, 1981 and this Ordinance is effective immediately.
