AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE PROVIDING A PERSONNEL AND PAY CLASSIFICATION FOR THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE:

WHEREAS, the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, wishes to provide personnel classifications for employment by the City, and wishes to provide a uniform pay classification for each position established by the City,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE:

SECTION ONE

There is hereby established within the City of Dry Ridge the job classifications listed in Section Two of this Ordinance. Personnel to fill such positions may be employed by executive order of the Mayor and persons so employed shall be paid compensation at the rate specified in such order provided, however, that such compensation shall not be less than the minimum nor more than the maximum hereinafter set out for such position.

SECTION THREE

The Mayor by executive order shall fix the salary of each employee and will show the annual salary based on a fifty-two (52) week year and an hourly rate of pay based on a forty (40) hour week, and will further provide in the executive order whether such employee is to be paid on a weekly or an hourly basis, and the pay period of each officer

or employee.

SECTION FOUR

Part-time employees shall be paid within the hourly rates of the position for which employed. The specific rate shall be fixed by executive order of the Mayor.

SECTION FIVE

Each employee hired pursuant to this Ordinance serves at the pleasure of the Mayor and may be dischraged at any time with or without notice and with or without cause.
