

ORDINANCE NO. 479-1992

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE ESTABLISHING AN INCREASED RATE AND CHARGE FOR WATER DISPENSED AT THE CITY'S LOADING STATION ON MEEKS ROAD IN THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE AND AMENDING CITY OF DRY RIDGE ORDINANCE NO. 453-1990.

WHEREAS, the tariff and water rates charged to customers of the City of Dry Ridge must yield revenues sufficient to pay the costs incurred by the city to purchase water from the city's supplier and to maintain the city's water system and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the cost for water supplied to the City of Dry Ridge is to be increased by the city's supplier which increase cannot be absorbed and paid by the city itself; and, therefore, such increase must be passed onto the city's customers under the increased tariff and rate set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE that the charge for water dispensed at the city's loading station on Meeks Road be increased, fixed and established and Ordinance No. 453-1990 be amended as follows:

SECTION ONE

The rate and charge present of ~~Four Dollars (\$4.00)~~ for each one thousand (1,000) gallons of water dispensed at the city's water loading station located on Meeks Road be and the same is hereby increased, established and fixed at the rate and charge of Six Dollars (\$6.00) for each unit of one thousand (1,000) gallons of water dispensed at said water loading station.

SECTION TWO

The rate and charge for water provided at the city's water loading station on Meeks Road so increased, established and fixed in Section One of this Ordinance shall be effective upon the due passage and publication of this Ordinance.
