AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE FORMATION OF A JOINT LOCAL INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY IN GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT, COUNTY OF GRANT, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMSTOWN, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRITTENDEN AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORINTH:

## Section One

The Fiscal Court of Grant County, Kentucky, shall enter into a Joint Local Industrial Development Authority to act cooperatively with signatory City Councils for the implementation of a joint Local Industrial Development Authority pursuant to KRS 154.50-316 and hereby directs the County Judge/Executive to execute the agreement essentially in the form as laid out in Section Two.

## Section Two

This Joint Local Industrial Agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") is made by and between the Grant County Fiscal Court and the City Councils of the City of Crittenden, City of Dry Ridge, City of Williamstown and City of Corinth, all of Grant County, Commonwealth of Kentucky.

## WITNESSETH:

Whereas, the Grant County Fiscal Court and the City Councils of the City of Crittenden and City of Dry Ridge, have each enacted ordinances establishing a Local Economic Industrial Development Authority and;

Whereas, the City of Williamstown and the City of Corinth have been consulted by each of the other Cities mentioned herein and the County of Grant and have expressed their interest in joining together to establish one unified Local Economic Development Authority within Grant County, Kentucky; and

Whereas, it is the intention of the parties hereto to

cooperate with each other by jointly using their powers on the basis of mutual advantage and thereby to provide services and facilities in a more efficient manner and pursuant thereto to form an organization that will accord best with geographic, economic, population and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities; and

Whereas, this includes acting cooperatively to authorize the appropriate organizational structure and administrative entity within the parties geographic area for implementation of a joint Local Industrial Development Authority pursuant to KRS 154.50-316; and

Whereas, the Grant County Fiscal Court and the City Councils, as parties, form a contiguous area thereby facilitating the delivery of the services and enhancement of the facilities envisioned herein; and

Whereas, the Grant County Fiscal Court and the signatory Cities, as parties hereto, have authorized their respective executive officers to give binding effect to this Agreement according to law by the execution of same by the affixing thereto of signatures by their duly appointed representatives; and

Whereas, the Agreement having been developed between public agencies in the joint exercise of power or authority which are capable of exercise by governmental agencies with each other:

NOW, THEREFORE, there is hereby created a Joint Local Industrial Development Authority as an entity for the development of employment opportunities, business and economic development and to promote the general welfare of the citizens of Grant County, Kentucky, and subject to the following:

- 1. Parties To This Agreement. Having passed this ordinance and having same recorded in their respective minutes, the County of Grant and the Cities of Crittenden, Dry Ridge, Williamstown and Corinth have become parties to this joint undertaking.
- 2. Agency Formation And Name. The name of the agency formed hereby shall be Grant County Joint Local Industrial Development Authority.
- 3. <u>Geographical Area Served</u>. The area served by the Grant County Joint Local Industrial Development Authority

shall include all of Grant County, Kentucky, to include all Cities located therein.

- 4. <u>Duration</u>. This ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1994, or upon its formal approval as required by law, whichever occurs later. It shall continue until terminated as provided by law.
- 5. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this Agreement is to form a Joint Local Industrial Development Authority and;
- (a) to create the organizational structure for the Grant County Joint Local Industrial Development Authority for the purposes of administering the programs and funding of industrial development in Grant County, Kentucky for the benefit of all parties signatory;

- (b) to establish the organization and procedure for the establishment of the Grant County Joint Local Industrial Development Authority and appointment of the members thereof, for the purpose of providing policy, guidance and general governmental oversight for all programs operated by the Grant County Joint Local Industrial Development Authority in accordance with KRS 154.50-301 et. seq.
- (c) to apply for, accept and receive funds from all lawful sources to facilitate the objectives of this Agreement.
- 6. Powers of Grant County Joint Local Industrial Development Authority. The Grant County Joint Local Industrial Development Authority shall have and exercise all powers conferred by the applicable portions of KRS Chapter 154.50, to include any amendments thereto made from time to time.
- 7. Organization. The parties signatory shall appoint, in accordance with KRS 154.50-326, for a term commensurate and in accordance therewith, the members of the authority herein established. This authority shall have all of the authority to manage the affairs of the Grant County Joint Local Industrial Development Authority consistent with state law, the provisions of this Agreement and the By-Laws adopted by the Authority which shall not be inconsistent with state law.
- 8. By-Laws. The Authority shall adopt such rules and by-laws as it deems necessary to accomplish its purposes and the reasonable conduct of its business.

9. Organizational Responsibility. The Authority shall have general responsibility for receipt, disbursement and accountability of any and all funds acquired by the Grant County Joint Local Industrial Development Authority. The Authority shall direct compliance with all applicable regulations concerning the receipt and disbursement of public or private funds. Each party to this Agreement shall bear its pro rata share for the cost of the programs and services delivered. The pro rata cost shall be determined as follows:

County of Grant	41%
City of Williamstown	30%
City of Crittenden	7.5%
City of Dry Ridge	21%
City of Corinth	.5%

- pursuant to this Agreement shall be considered the joint property of all the parties to the Agreement and shall be held in trust by the Grant County Joint Local Industrial Development Authority and used for those purposes allowed by KRS Chapter 154.50.
- 11. Withdrawal. Withdrawal by any governmental unit party signatory shall be accomplished in accordance with KRS 154.50-330 as same exists at the execution of this agreement or as same may be amended from time to time hereafter.
- 12. Amendment. This Agreement may be amended as provided by law.
- 13. <u>Dissolution</u>. Dissolution of this Authority shall be accomplished in accordance with KRS 154.50-330 as same exists at the execution of this agreement or as same may be amended from time to time hereafter.
- 14. Approval. This Agreement shall become effective only when:
- (a) It is executed by the designated member of the signatory parties pursuant to authorization by same; and
- (b) Certified copies are filed with the offices of the Grant County Clerk and the Clerk of the respective parties signatory.
- 15. Repealer. All prior ordinances in conflict herewith, or any portion of any ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
