ORDINANCE NO. 579-1998

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, AMENDING SECTION 10.7(A) OF CITY OF DRY RIDGE ORDINANCE NO. 380-1982, THE OFFICIAL ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, SO ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL "PERMITTED USES" WITHIN THAT ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF CITY OF DRY RIDGE CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT (CBD).

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, has found and determined that Section 10.7(A) of the Official Zoning Ordinance of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, Ordinance No. 380-1982, needs to be amended so as to establish and set forth therein additional "permitted uses" within the zoning classification of City of Dry Ridge Central Business District (CBD); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, desires and intends hereby to so amend Section 10.7(A) of Ordinance No. 380-1982, the Official Zoning Ordinance of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, to set forth and establish additional "permitted uses" within the CBD-Zone with the same heretofore approved upon Application and Public Hearing by and before the Grant County Joint Planning Commission at its meeting on August 24, 1998.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

That Section 10.7(A) of Ordinance No. 380-1982, the Official Zoning Ordinance of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, be and the same is hereby so duly amended and that the following, "permitted uses" be so hereby fixed and established as "permitted uses" allowed within that zoning classification of City of Dry Ridge Central Business District (CBD), to-wit:

SECTION 10.7 CBD (CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT) ZONE:
