AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, AMENDING SECTION THREE OF CITY OF DRY RIDGE ORDINANCE NO. 509-1994 CONCERNING THE FEES AND COSTS TO BE CHARGED TO RESIDENTIAL AND NON-RESIDENTIAL WATER USER/CUSTOMERS OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE'S MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM TO MAKE AND EFFECT A TAP-ON TO A WATER MAIN AND TO PUT AND SET A WATER METERING DEVICE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE AS FOLLOWS:

Section Three of City of Dry Ridge Ordinance No. 509-1994 be and the same is hereby amended as follows, to-wit:

"SECTION THREE"

The costs and charges payable to the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, to have the City of Dry Ridge make or supervise the making of a boring or tap into the city's water mains and lines and to set and install an appropriate water metering device or to supervise the setting and installation of an appropriate water metering device are so fixed, set and established as follows:

- Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) to make a tap and install the appropriate water metering device for a bore diameter of five-eight's (5/8ths) by three-fourth's (3/4ths) inches, plus costs and charges extraordinary as may be incurred by the City of Dry Ridge to so make and effect the requested tap and install the required water metering device for a residential user/customer only.
- To effect or supervise a tap having a bore diameter of greater than "5/8 x 3/4 inches", and install or supervise the installation of the appropriate water metering device for a bore diameter of greater than "5/8 the charges due and payable by the user/customer inches", 3/4 non-residential, shall be those costs and amounts as determined or estimated by the City of Dry Ridge to effect or supervise the tap and to effect or supervise the due installation of the required water metering device/unit, all duly set forth within a written agreement containing therein a provision and covenant regarding extraordinary expenses and costs which may be incurred by the city to effect or supervise the tap or installation of the appropriate water metering device/unit, all payable by the city's user/customer non-residential before the water lines be charged or service provided, and with such costs and charges to the non-residential user/customer being not less than the sum and amount of Five-Hundred-Dollars-(\$500,00)-Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) plus all costs and expenses actual and extraordinary, all payable by the user/customer non-residential.
