ORDINANCE NO. 600-1999

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, AMENDING ARTICLE VII, SECTION ONE OF CITY OF DRY RIDGE ORDINANCES NO. 354-1980 AND NO. 573-1998 THEREBY **ESTABLISHING** NEW CONNECTION FEES AND CHARGES RELATING TO THE USE OF THE CITY'S MUNICIPAL SEWER SYSTEM.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE VII

Fees and Charges.

Section One of Article VII of City of Dry Ridge Ordinance No. 354-1980 and No. 573-1998 b and the same are hereby amended as follows:

- Section 1. The following connection fees shall be charged for all connections made to the sanitary sewer system within the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, and it shall be the duty of the City to collect said fees:
- (1) Commercial Establishments. The connection fee for each commercial establishment shall be ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$1,250.00) TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00).
- (2) **Industrial Establishments.** The connection fee for each industrial establishment shall be TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500.00) FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4,000.00).
- (3) Residential Establishments. The connection fee for residential establishments shall be as follows:

- (a) Single-family dwellings, Two-family dwellings, Duplexes, and Two-Unit Apartment structures ---- SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$625.00) SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$750.00).
- (b) Apartment buildings having 3 to 8 units ---- ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$1,250.00) per building TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) per building.
- (c) Apartment buildings having 9 to 16 units ---- ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,500.00) per building TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500.00) per building.
- (d) Apartment buildings have 17 or more units ---- ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS per unit TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) per unit.
- (4) Transient-Commercial, Governmental, and Residential-Type Uses and Facilities for Such Uses.

 The connection fee for such use-type, or facility shall be NINE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$950.00) ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) for each such facility plus ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) per each room made available for occupancy/use by customers, or expected users of a hotel, motel, or term-occupant, or patient of a hospital, nursing home or extended care facility, or each room to be used as a classroom or restroom in and educational building or educational facility.
- (5) Multi-Use Buildings and Facilities. Where a building or facility has more than one permitted use, the greater or greatest fee or charge herein and hereunder for such permitted use shall be charged, exacted or levied for the sewer line connection.

The herein fees and charges for sewer line and sewer main connections to the City of Dry Ridge's Municipal Sewer System shall become effective when the herein ordinance is passed, adopted, ordained, ordered published and published according to law.
