

ORDINANCE NO. 621-2001

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE CITY'S EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION PLAN AND ORDINANCE TO REFLECT AND PROVIDE FOR A COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT (COLA), WHERE APPLICABLE FOR THE 01-02 SALARY SCALE AND SUCH EMPLOYEE SALARY SCALES THEREAFTER, WHERE APPLICABLE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE AS FOLLOWS:

Section One

That the 01-02 Salary Scale hereto attached and made a part hereof, which increases the minimum and maximum of each employee salary range by 3.40 percent (3.40%) to reflect a cost-of-living increase for the calendar-year of 2000, shall replace and amend such salary scale heretofore adopted and included within the city's employee compensation plan and policies.

Section Two

That the City of Dry Ridge's Employee Compensation Plan or Employee Policies and any attachments, schedules or amendments thereto may be waived, altered or suspended only by change of ordinance, administrative orders, or executive orders whichever is applicable.
