AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE AND COLLECTION WASTE RESIDENTIAL SOLID ORDINANCE, NO. 598-1999, TO LEVY UPON AND COLLECT FROM EACH CITY'S RESIDENTIAL WASTE COLLECTION AND REMOVAL CUSTOMERS THE "ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION FEE" FOR EACH TON OR GENERATED OF WASTE THEREOF FRACTIONAL PART RESIDENTIAL WASTE COLLECTION AND REMOVAL CUSTOMERS REQUIRED AND MANDATED BY HOUSE BILL NO. 174/KRS 224.43-010, ET SEQ..

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky under House Bill 174/KRS 224.43-010, adopted and enacted on April 15, 2002, concerning solid waste management and disposal, has mandated that a fee or surcharge known as an "environmental remediation fee" in the amount of One Dollar and Seventy-Five Cents (\$1.75) for each ton, or fractional part thereof, of waste generated and collected be exacted and paid by the generator thereof at the time of disposal; and

WHEREAS, the above "environmental remediation fee" will be exacted upon the City of Dry Ridge by its waste collection and disposal provider beginning January 1, 2003, which costs are hereby to be passed on to the generators thereof, the city's residential waste collection and disposal customers under the amendments hereto.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

The City of Dry Ridge's solid waste collection and disposal ordinance, No. 598-1999, be and the same is hereby amended as follows, to-wit:

ARTICLE FOUR

That beginning for the utilities' billing period following the adoption and enactment of the amendments to the herein ordinance, there shall be added to each customer's bill and charge current for residential waste collection and disposal services the sum and amount monthly of Twenty Cents $(20\Phi)/0.20$ Dollars (\$0.20).
