AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, RELATING TO AND CONCERNING RESIDENTIAL, SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND REMOVAL SERVICES TO AND FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE CITIZENS AND RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY; RATIFYING, CONFIRMING AND ADOPTING THE JOINT AND CONCURRENT COLLECTIVE BIDDING PROCEDURES FOR SUCH RESIDENTIAL. SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND REMOVAL SERVICES AND RESIDENTS HAD BY THE CITIES OF CORINTH. CITIZENS CRITTENDEN. DRY RIDGE AND WILLIAMSTOWN BY INTERLOCAL AND INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT; THE DUE ACCEPTANCE OF THE OFFER AND BID OF CSI FOR SUCH RESIDENTIAL, SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND REMOVAL SERVICES FOR AND WITHIN THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY; AND ESTABLISHMENT OF MONTHLY RATE AND CHARGE TO BE LEVIED. EXACTED AND PAID BY RESIDENTS AND CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF DRY KENTUCKY FOR SUCH RESIDENTIAL, SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND REMOVAL SERVICES BEGINNING ON OR ABOUT OCTOBER 15, 1999, AND AMENDING CITY OF DRY RIDGE ORDINANCE NO. 598-1999.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE ONE

That the heretofore joint, concurrent and collective actions regarding collective bidding notices concerning and procedures for residential, solid waste collection and removal services for the citizens and residents of the cities of Corinth, Crittenden, Dry Ridge, and Williamstown, so done and concluded by interlocal actions and interlocal agreement, be and the same are hereby ratified, confirmed, adopted and approved.

ARTICLE TWO

for residential, solid waste That the offer and bid collection and removal services made pursuant to the joint and concurrent actions and under the interlocal agreement referred to in Article One above by CSI is hereby accepted and approved by and for the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky.

ARTICLE THREE

That for the current term of the said CSI Solid Waste Collection and Removal Contract beginning in the fiscal-year of 2003 and concluding in the fiscal-year of 2005, and so beginning on or about July 1, 2003, the monthly charge for residential, solid waste collection and removal services shall be the sum and amount of Five Dollars and Seventy-Five Cents (\$5.75) to be billed to and paid by the residents and citizens of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky.
