ORDINANCE NO. 653-2003

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, AUTHORIZING THE ENTERING OF AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE GRANT COUNTY FISCAL COURT (THE COUNTY OF GRANT) AND THE CITIES OF CORINTH, CRITTENDEN AND WITLLIAMSTOWN ADDRESSING THE CONSOLIDATION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SERVICE FUNCTIONS WITHIN GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the City Councils or Commissions of Dry Ridge, Corinth, Crittenden and Williamstown, and the Fiscal Court of the County of Grant have participated in discussions designed to combine the emergency management functions of these respective entities;

WHEREAS, the above discussions concerning the combining of emergency management functions have resulted in decisions by each of the aforementioned entities that a joint service effort would be beneficial to each of the parties; and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Dry Ridge, Corinth, Crittenden and Williamstown together with the County of Grant have memorialized their discussions and agreements in a document styled "Interlocal Agreement Providing Emergency Management Services" within Grant County, Kentucky.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE FOR THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Article One

That the City of Dry Ridge, Grant County, Kentucky, enter into an agreement with the Cities of Corinth, Crittenden and Williamstown and with the Fiscal Court of the County of Grant as outlined in that document attached hereto and styled "Interlocal Agreement Providing Emergency Management Services" within Grant County, Kentucky.

Article Two

That the Mayor of the City of Dry Ridge execute the said Interlocal Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Dry Ridge and, thereafter, attend to its proper administration.

Article Three

That all ordinance or portions thereof which may be in conflict with this Ordinance shall be, and the same are, repealed.
