AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, REPEALING CITY OF DRY RIDGE ORDINANCE NO. 641-2003 AS HERETOFORE ENACTED PURSUANT TO KRS 190.030(7) ALLOWING FOR THE OFF-SITE, TEMPORARY SALES OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE LIMITS CORPORATE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, did pursuant to KRS 190.030(7) under duly enacted City of Dry Ridge Ordinance No. 641-2003 did allow for the off-site, temporary sale of motor vehicles within the limits corporate of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, has reconsidered the propriety of allowing for the off-site, temporary sales of motor vehicles so finding such activities to be not in the best interests of and to the health and well-being of the residents, citizens and persons within the limits corporate to the extent and degree that Ordinance No. 641-2003 allowing for the off-site, temporary sales of motor vehicles should and shall hereby be repealed.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

City of Dry Ridge Ordinance No. 641-2003 heretofore enacted allowing for the off-site, temporary sale of motor vehicles pursuant to KRS 190.030(7) be and the same is hereby repealed.
