

**ORDINANCE NO.** 741-2009

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE'S ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE 2008-2009 FISCAL-YEAR TO ESTABLISH AND CREATE WITHIN SAID BUDGET AN ADDITIONAL ACCOUNTING CATEGORY AND LEDGER ENTRY COLUMN TO BE KNOWN AS THE "CEDAR CREST KIA GRANT FUND" INTO WHICH SPECIFICALLY DESIGNATED GRANT FUNDS AND MONIES FROM THE KENTUCKY INFRASTRUCTURE AUTHORITY (KIA) WILL BE RECEIVED AND DEPOSITED BY THE CITY AND THEREAFTER DISBURSED AS INSTRUCTED BY THE SAID KENTUCKY INFRASTRUCTURE AUTHORITY (KIA).

**BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:**

GENERAL ARTICLE

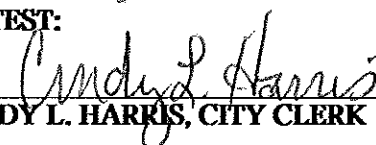
Whereas, the City of Dry Ridge, Grant County, Kentucky, has agreed to be the grant monies receipting and disbursement factor for Kentucky Infrastructure Authority grant funds and monies for the Cedar Crest Subdivision PTP Construction Project under State Application Identifier Number: SAI#KY20080721-0836 during the current 2008-2009 fiscal-year and thereafter as may be required, the city is required to amend the city's annual and current budget for the 2008-2009 fiscal-year to reflect and account for the aforesaid KIA grant funds and monies; therefore, the said annual budget of the City of Dry Ridge, Grant County, Kentucky, for the said 2008-2009 fiscal-year be and the same is amended to add an additional accounting category and ledger entry column in and within said budget to be known and referred to as the "CEDAR CREST KIA GRANT FUND" into which specifically designated grant funds and monies from the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority (KIA) will be received and deposited and thereafter disbursed as instructed by the said Kentucky Infrastructure Authority (KIA) in connection with the aforesaid Cedar Crest PTP Project.
