

ORDINANCE NO. 759-2011

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, REPEALING CITY OF DRY RIDGE ORDINANCE NO. 740-2008 SO CONCERNING MANDATORY RESPONSIBLE BEVERAGE SERVER TRAINING.

WHEREAS, the City of Dry Ridge heretofore in conjunction with the adoption of an ordinance pursuant to KRS 242.185, et seq., relating to the licensing and sale of alcoholic beverages within restaurants, did adopt a companion ordinance, No. 740-2008, regarding mandatory beverage server training; and

WHEREAS, the above and foregoing matters having been reviewed and considered, it is found and determined that such beverage server training is not required under the aegis of the city and that Ordinance No. 740-2008 should be repealed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

General Article

That City of Dry Ridge Ordinance No. 740-2008 concerning and related to mandatory alcohol-beverage server training be and the same is hereby repealed.


