

ORDINANCE NO. 777-2013

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING CITY OF DRY RIDGE ORDINANCE NO. 739-2008 ENACTED ON DECEMBER 22, 2008, RELATING TO THE LICENSING OF RESTAURANTS AND DINING FACILITIES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY THE DRINK WHEN SUCH FACILITIES SEAT A MINIMUM OF ONE HUNDRED (100) PERSONS AND DERIVE A MINIMUM OF SEVENTY PERCENT (70%) OF GROSS RECEIPTS FROM THE SALE OF FOOD TO MAKE AND EFFECT CHANGES AND AMENDMENTS NECESSARY AS TO THE LICENSING AND SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LOCALLY DUE TO THE ENACTMENT OF SENATE BILL 13 (SB 13).

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

GENERAL ARTICLE ONE

(1) City of Dry Ridge Ordinance No. 739-2008 regarding the licensing and sale of alcoholic beverages within the City of Dry Ridge as heretofore ordained on December 22, 2008, be and the same is hereby duly reaffirmed, readopted and re-ordained save as hereby and hereinafter amended.

(2) That City of Dry Ridge Ordinance No. 739-2008 concerning the limited sale locally of alcoholic beverages within restaurants as heretofore adopted, and ordained, and herein above reaffirmed, be and the same is hereby amended as follows, to-wit:

"SECTION I"

Purpose and License Specificity ...

This ordinance is adopted to regulate the sale of alcohol pursuant to KRS 242.185 in such manner as to effectuate the legislative intent of that statute. That intent is to permit the sale of alcoholic beverages by the drink at restaurants and dining facilities which seat at least one hundred persons and derive a minimum of seventy percent (70%) of their gross receipts from the sale of food, under issued license, which is now designated and defined within Senate Bill 13 as a combination license allowing and permitting the on-site sale and ingestion only of distilled spirits, wine, and malt beverages (beer) by the drink only within a restaurant facility seating 100 persons at tables; and so also deriving a minimum of seventy percent (70%) of its gross receipts from the sale of food and under a duly issued NQ-2 Retail Drink License and being the only license allowed within the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, as so initially ordained and intended and so now assured and provided for:




