A MUNICIPAL RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, IN GRANT COUNTY,  
KENTUCKY, ADOPTING

“Warsaw Road Sidewalk Project Acceptance of Federal Highway Funds”

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dry Ridge, Grant County, Kentucky, is a Kentucky Municipal entity and a home rule city, acting by and through it’s City Council and Mayor and having 31 Broadway, Dry Ridge, Kentucky 41035, as its seat of government from which it engages in activities governmental; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Members of the Dry Ridge City Council did at a meeting held on September 18, 2017, find and conclude that the federal-aid highway program state administered funding was awarded the amount of **\$256,000**, and;

**WHEREAS**, this amount will be **authorized in phases** as federal requirements are met for the Warsaw Road Sidewalk Project, and ;

**WHEREAS**, City of Dry Ridge does hereby authorize the Mayor to sign the above mentioned Agreement, as well as any other necessary documents relating to the project.
