ORDINANCE NO. 873-2020**

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE ROAD ON THE SOUTHSIDE OF FERGUSON BLVD “SGT DANIEL WALLACE WAY”

WHEREAS, the road named “**SGT DANIEL WALLACE WAY**” lies only within the city limits of DRY RIDGE, Kentucky, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, due to significant economic development in the area, the City needed to add to its infrastructure and build a new road to aid in said economic development;

WHEREAS, Army Sgt Daniel W. Wallace was a Dry Ridge resident and died on October 31, 2008 while serving during Operation Enduring Freedom. Sergeant Daniel Wallace was assigned to the 201st Engineer Battalion, Kentucky Army National Guard in Cynthiana, Kentucky and was killed in action in Badin Kheyl, Afghanistan, of wounds sustained when insurgents attacked his unit using small arms fire.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY:

Section 1

That said road lying on the southside of Ferguson Blvd., within the city limits of DRY RIDGE, shall be named “**SGT DANIEL WALLACE WAY**”.

Section 2

That all property owners and residents of properties lying within the city limits of DRY RIDGE, Kentucky, and addressed along said road, shall be notified of this ordinance for clarification purposes.

Section 3

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published, and recorded according to law.
