

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OR STANDING OF VEHICLES ON BOTH SIDES OF BROADWAY STREET OR TAFT HIGHWAY FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH U.S. 25 WESTWARDLY TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH HIGHWAY INTER-STATE 75.

WHEREAS, the City has been requested by the proper officials of the Kentucky Department of Highways to eliminate parking of vehicles on Broadway Street because of the increased flow of traffic on said street, due to its being used as the only route to and from the southern terminus of Interstate Highway 75, and

WHEREAS, this action is deemed necessary by this Council in order to protect the health and welfare of its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

No owner or operator of any vehicle shall, at and time, permit same to be parked or left standing on Broadway Street Kentucky Highway 22 or Taft Highway, from its intersection with U.S. 25 to its intersection with Interstate Highway 75.

SECTION II

Any person, firm or corporation found guilty of violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than TWO DOLLARS (\$2.00) nor more than FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00) for each offense.

SECTION III

All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION IV

If any section, paragraph or clause of this ordinance be held by a proper court to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining sections, paragraphs or clauses, it being hereby expressly declared that the remainder of said ordinance would have been passed despite such invalidity.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
