

ORDINANCE NO. 205

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATION THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BIDS RECEIVED BY THE CITY FOR THE FURNISHING OF A CAB AND CHASSIS FOR FIRE EQUIPMENT AND FOR THE FIRE PUMPER AND EQUIPMENT AND ACCEPTING SAID BIDS AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY TO EXECUTE FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY A CONTRACT WITH THE SAID LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDERS.

WHEREAS, the City has heretofore advertised for bids for the furnishing of a cab and chassis for the purpose of mounting thereon certain fire pumper equipment and the fire pumper equipment itself, and

WHEREAS, this Council has received said bids and has duly studied all of the bids received, and

WHEREAS, it has determined which of said bids are the lowest responsible bids for each of the said items.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1

That it is hereby determined that the bid of T & W FORD SALES, Williamstown, Kentucky in the sum of FOUR THOUSAND FIFTY-THREE DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-SEVEN CENTS (\$4053.77), is the lowest responsible bid received for the furnishing of the cab and chassis.

SECTION 11

That the said bid of the T & W FORD SALES, Williamstown, Kentucky in the sum of FOUR THOUSAND FIFTY-THREE DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-SEVEN CENTS (\$4053.77), be, and the same is hereby accepted.

SECTION 111

That it is hereby determined that the bid of the Midwest Fire and Safety Equipment Company of Indianapolis, Indiana, is the lowest responsible bid received for the furnishing of the pumping equipment to be mounted on the aforesaid cab and chassis.

SECTION LV

That the bid of FOURTEEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY DOLLARS (\$14,180.00) of the Midwest Fire and Safety Equipment Company of Indianapolis, Indiana for the furnishing of the said pumper and equipment be, and the same is hereby accepted.

SECTION V

That D. W. Dills as Mayor of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky be, and he is hereby authorized, ordered and directed to sign

contracts with the T&W Ford Sales, Williamstown, Kentucky for the furnishing of said cab and chassis in accordance with the specifications and bid and advertisement for bids therefor and to sign for and on behalf of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky a contract with the Midwest Fire and Safety Equipment Company, of Indianapolis, Indiana for the furnishing of the fire pumper equipment and apparatus in accordance with the advertisement for bids, plans and specifications and the bid of the said Midwest Fire and Safety Equipment Company of Indianapolis, Indiana.

SECTION VI

All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION VIII

If any section, paragraph or clause of this ordinance be held by a proper court to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remainder of said ordinance, being hereby expressly declared that the remaining sections, paragraphs or clauses would have been passed despite such invalidity.
