

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND CREATING THE OFFICE OF POLICE JUDGE PRO TEM OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY; PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES, QUALIFICATIONS AND TERM OF SAID OFFICE; FIXING THE COMPENSATION THEREOF AND APPOINTING AND ELECTING THE POLICE JUDGE PRO TEM FOR THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by this Council that there is a need for someone to be designated to act in the place of the duly elected Police Judge when he is absent or cannot preside or is sworn off the bench, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by this Council that the office of Police Judge Pro Tem should be created and established in order to fill this need, and

WHEREAS, this Council has made a study of available persons to fill said office.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

#### SECTION L

That there be and there is hereby created and established the office of Police Judge Pro Tem of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky.

#### SECTION 11

The qualifications for said office shall be the same as those prescribed by law for the Police Judge of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky.

## SECTION 111

The person holding the office of Police Judge Pro Tem shall act as Police Judge and perform the same duties of the Police Judge when the Police Judge is absent or cannot preside or has been sworn off the bench.

## SECTION 1V

The Police Judge Pro Tem shall be elected by and serve at the pleasure of the City Council.

## SECTION V

The Police Judge Pro Tem shall receive as full compensation for his services the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per month. Same to be paid from the general funds of the City.

## SECTION VI

That Eric D. McBee be and he is hereby appointed and elected to fill the office of Police Judge Pro Tem of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky.

## SECTION VII

All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

## SECTION VIII

If any section, paragraph or clause of this ordinance be held to be invalid by a proper court such invalidity shall not affect the remaining sections, paragraphs or clauses, it being hereby expressly declared that the remainder of this ordinance would have been passed despite such invalidity.

## SECTION IX

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
