## RESOLUTION NO. 214, 1963

A RESOLUTION ENGAGING THE SERVICES AND EMPLOYING ELMER G. BERLING, JR., ATTORNEY AT LAW, AS CITY ATTORNEY FOR THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, KENTUCKY, FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION TO AND IN#: CLUDING DECEMBER 31, 1963, ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Dry Ridge, Grant County, Kentucky, as follows:

- l. That the City of Dry Ridge does hereby retain and engage the services of Elmer G. Berling, Jr., as City Attorney for the City of Dry Ridge, to represent the said City in any and all legal matters in which the City is now, or may in the future, become involved from the effective date of this Resolution to and indluding December 31, 1963.
- 2. That the salary for the said City Attorney during the period of time established by this Resolution, shall be the sum of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars for each attendance at the regular meetings of the Dry Ridge City Council on the first Tuesday of each and every month.
- 3. That the aforesaid salary does not include any other representation in addition to attendance at the regular monthly meeting on the first Tuesday of each month and such additional representation, if any, will be paid for at a fee to be determined hereafter.

This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force, when passed, approved, published and adopted according to law.
