

ORDINANCE NO. 223

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE TO MAINTAIN THEIR PROPERTY IN A NEAT, PRESENTABLE AND SANITARY CONDITION AND SETTING A PENALTY THEREFORE,

Whereas it appears necessary for the City Council to regulate the manner in which residents, and occupants of residences, maintain their property within the City of Dry Ridge in order to prevent nuisances with in the City it is hereby Ordained by the City Council as follows:

1. That it shall be the duty of the occupant of any residence within the City of Dry Ridge to maintain the property where they reside in a neat, presentable and sanitary condition and not to allow rubbish, trash or refuse of any type to accumulate or remain upon the property.

2. That any person found guilty of violating this Ordinance by the Dry Ridge Police Court shall be fined not less than Ten (\$10.00) nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) and each day that the said nuisance shall continue shall be considered as a seperate offense.

3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect when passed, adopted and published according to law.
