ORDINANCE NO. 224

An ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 151 OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the City of Dry Ridge has determined that Ordinance No. 151 requiring reconstruction and/or improvement of public ways, waterline, streets, and other public improvements in newly annexed territories should be repealed because it makes annexation of additional territory difficult,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS;

SECTION I

That Ordinance No. 151 entitled, "An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 122 heretofore passed to provide for the construction, reconstruction and/or improvement of public ways, water lines, streets, street improvement of public ways, sidewalk improvements, sewers and sewerage system improvement in all areas, lands and territories which may from time to time be annexed and included in the corporate limits of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, and to further provide for the construction, reconstruction and/or improvement of public ways, water lines, streets, street improvement, sidewalk improvements, sewer and sewerage system improvement located within the present corporate limits of the City of Dry Ridge," be and the same is hereby repealed.
