

ORDINANCE NO 227

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL STREET LIGHTING UNITS.

WHEREAS, ORDINANCE NO. 826 provides for the lighting of the streets and other public places in the City.

WHEREAS, said ordinance contains a provision that The Union Light, Heat and Power Company shall install additional street lighting units at the same rates and under the same conditions as contained in said Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, Council has determined the need for additional street lighting, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, STATE OF KENTUCKY:

SECTION I

That the public welfare and safety requires the following changes to the street lighting system;

That The Union Light, Heat and Power Company shall alter the street lighting system at the locations designated above, in accordance with the terms and conditions of Ordinance No. 227, and, the Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to notify the Company of the action of Council by transmitting to that Company a certified copy of this ordinance.

SECTION III

In all other respects the terms and conditions of Ordinance No. ~~226~~ (as ammended) shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION IV

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
