

ORDINANCE NO. 238, 1966

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OR OPERATION OF UN-LICENSED MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AND PROHIBITING THE USE OR OPERATION OF SUCH VEHICLES EMITTING LOUD NOISES AND NOXIOUS OR UNPLEASANT ODORS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

I

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate an unlicensed motor vehicle within the city limits of Dry Ridge, Grant County, Kentucky, except that the provisions hereof shall not apply to farm tractors.

II

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to use or operate any motor vehicle within the city limits of the City of Dry Ridge, Grant County, Kentucky, whether licensed or not, if same shall emit loud and disturbing sounds and noises, or noxious

fumes and odors and smoke of a gaseous nature, offensive to smell.

III

Violation of the foregoing shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$ 5.00; where the person, firm or corporation, commits more than three violations of the foregoing within a period of twelve months, the vehicle of said person, firm or corporation shall be impounded by proper authority of said city and shall be redeemable only upon payment of a fine of \$ 50.00 and costs of impoundment.
