

ORDANCE NO. 251

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL STREET LIGHTING UNITS.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 226 provides for the lighting of the streets and other public places in the City.

WHEREAS, said Ordinance contains a provision that the Union Light, Heat and Power Company shall install additional street lighting units at the same rates and under the same terms and conditions as contained in said Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, Council has determined the need for additional said lighting,

NOW, THEREFORE., BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, STATE OF KENTUCKY:

SECTION ONE

That the public welfare and safety requires the following changes to the street lighting system:

In all other respects the terms and conditions of Ordinance No. 226 (as amended) shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION FOUR

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
