ORDANCE NO. 251

AN ORDIANCE PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL STREET LIGHTING UNITS.

WHEREAS, Ordiance No. 226 provides for the lighting of the streets and other public places in the City.

WHEREAS, s aid Ordiance contains a provision that the Union Light, Heat and Pow er Company shall install additional street lighting units at the same rates and under the same terms and conditions as contained in said Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, Council has determined the need for additional said lighting,

NOW, THEREFORE., BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE, STATE OF KENTUCKY:

SECTION ONE

That the public welfare and safety requires the following changes to the s treet lighting system:

That the Union Light, Heat and Power Company be and it hereby is authorized and directed to make the aforementioned change in the street lighting system, including the installation and/or replacement of all necessary poles, wires and anchors, and that the Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to notify the Company of the action of Council by transmitting to that Company a certified copy of this Ordiance.

SECTION THREE

In all other respects the terms and conditions of Ordiance No. 22 (as amended) shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION FOUR

That this Ordiance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
