The Board of Trustees of the Town of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, in regular session for business Tuesday night, December 3, 1935, do ordain as follows:

Whereas, the necessary majority of the residents and legal voters of the Town of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, have consented in writing that the Board of Trustees of the said Town take the necessary action to strike from the present corporate limits of the said Town, the following described territory:

"Beginning at a point in the west line of the old corporation line of the said Town of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, at a point 150 feet south of the south line of the right of way of Broadway Street, thence in a southeasterly direction 660 feet to a fence post, corner to A.P. Boswell and Victoria Eyers; thence in a southwesterly direction with the line of A.P. Boswell 268 feet, more or less, to the south corporation line; thence with the old corporate line back to the beginning."

Now, the Board of Trustees of the said Town of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, does ordain that the above described property be stricken from the present corporate limits of the said Town of Dry Ridge, Kentucky; and that four (4) copies of this ordinance be posted in public places within the said Town.

All members present and all members voting "Yea."
