#### ORDINANCE NO. 90

An ordinance proposing to annex to the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, certain unincorporated territory lying in Grant County, Kentucky, and adjoining the corporate limits of said City, and accurately describing the boundary of the territory proposed to be annexed.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the City of Dry Ridge, Grant County, Kentucky.

#### SECTION 1.

That it is hereby deemed advisable and it is hereby proposed to annex to the City of Dry Hidge, Kentucky, all that unincorporated territory lying in Grant County, Kentucky, and adjoining the corporate limits of said city, described by metes and and bounds as follows: To-wit:

Beginning at intersection of old corporation line back of Porter Roland in a southernly course back of Craig Webb's home

to south school line, 394 feet thence with said south school line in a easternly course crossing railroad and highway to a point in McLachlan and Stephenson line 1004 feet thence in a northernly course back of McLachlan and Lowe to a point in Northcutt and Blackburn line to a dead Popular, 2550 feet thence west crossing railroad and highway and following line of Guy Conrad and Howard Brewer to north west corner Porter Roland lot in Conrad subdivision 831 feet thence south with west line of said lots to corporate line in Mrs. Wilson west property line, 1100 feet. Lines and lengths more or less of above.

## SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall be posted (or copies of same) for at least ten days in four of the most public places in Town. Also in County paper for four issues.

# SECTION 3.

After the expiration of thirty (30) days from the enactment of this ordinance, and after same shall have been published as provided in Section 2 hereof, if no petition shall have been filed in the Grant County Circuit Court, setting forth reasons why the territory defined in Section 1 of this ordinance should not be annexed to the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, the Board of Trustees will enact an ordinance annexing to the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, the territory defined in Section 1 of this ordinance, and upon the enactment of such ordinance the aforesaid territory shall be annexed to the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, and become a part thereof.

## SECTION 4.

This ordinance shall take effect when signed, recorded and published as required by law.
