

ORDINANCE NO. 95

An ordinance annexing to the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, unincorporated territory lying in Grant County, Kentucky, and adjoining the corporate limits of said City, And accurately describing the boundary of the territory annexed.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the City of Dry Ridge, Grant County, Kentucky.

SECTION 1.

That it is hereby deemed advisable to annex to the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, all that unincorporated territory lying in Grant County, Kentucky, And adjoining the corporate limits of said City described by metes and bounds as follows: To-Wit:

Beginning at intersection of old corporation line back of Porter Roland in southerly course back of Craig Webb's home to South School line, 394 feet, thence with said south school line in an easternly course crossing railroad and highway to a point in McLachlan and Stephenson line 1004 feet, thence in a northerly course back of McLachlan and Lowe to a point in Northcutt and Blackburn line to a dead popular 2550 feet, thence west crossing railroad and highway and following line of Guy Conrad and Howard Brewer, to northwest corner of Porter Roland lot in Conrad subdivision 331 feet, thence south with west line of said lots to corporate line in Mrs. Wilson's west property line 1100 feet, lines and lengths more or less of the above.

SECTION 2.

The Board of Trustess of the City of Dry Ridge, Grant County, Kentucky, at their regular meeting on the 6th day of August, 1940, held at the Town Hall in the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, enacted an ordinance proposing to annex the territory above described to the City of Dry Ridge; that said ordinance was published in four (4) issues of the Grant County News, the only newspaper published in Grant County, Kentucky, which is a weekly newspaper, And that numerous copies of said ordinance were posted in more than four (4) of the most public places in the Town of Dry Ridge, Grant County, Kentucky, And that more than thirty (30) days have expired since the enactment of said ordinance proposing the annexation of said territory, And no petition having been filed in the Grant County Circuit Court setting forth any reasons why the territory defined in said ordinance should not be annexed to the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, it is therefore ordained by the Board of Trustees of the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, that said territory as above described be, and the same is here-

by annexed to the City of Dry Ridge, Kentucky, Grant County.

SECTION 3.

This ordinance shall take effect when signed and recorded and published as required by law.
