

MUNICIPAL ORDER NO. 2019-02

**A MUNICIPAL ORDER OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE IN GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY MAKING THE WRITTEN DETERMINATIONS REQUIRED BY KRS 82.083 FOR THE SALE OR OTHER DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY**

**WHEREAS**, THE City of DRY RIDGE now owns property that is no longer useful or beneficial to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, KRS 82.083 establishes certain requirements for the disposition of such property;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby ORDERED and DETERMINED by the City of DRY RIDGE as follows

**Section 1.0 Written Determinations Required by KRS 82.083**

Pursuant to the requirements of KRS 82.083 for the sale or other disposition of property owned by the City, it is hereby determined that the property described herein is no longer needed or beneficial to the City; and shall be disposed of by one of the following methods of KRS 82.083:

2. Transferred, with or without compensation, to another governmental agency
3. Sold at public auction following publication of the auction in accordance with KRS 424.130(1)(b).
4. Sold by electronic auction following publication of the auction, including the uniform resource link (URL) for the site of the electronic auction, in accordance with KRS 424.130(1)(b).
5. Sold by sealed bids in accordance with the procedure for sealed bids under KRS 45A.365(3) and (4).
7. Sold for its appraised fair market value or a greater amount if the property is valued at five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or less in an independent appraisal.

Property sold under this paragraph may not be sold to a city officer or employee or family member of a city officer or employee as defined in the city's ethics ordinance adopted under KRS 65.003.

8. Sold for scrap or disposed of as garbage in a manner consistent with the public interest if the property has no value, or is of nominal value as determined by an independent appraisal.

## **Section 2.0 Written Descriptions Required by KRS 82.083**

Attached hereto and incorporated herein, is the description required by KRS 82.083 for the sale or other disposition of property owned by the City:

### **1. Property subject to disposition.**

### **2. Intended use of the property at the time of acquisition.**

The vehicle and dog were used as a K-9 Unit.

### **3. Reasons why it is in the public interest to dispose of the property.**

The City of Dry Ridge no longer has a K-9 Officer and therefore there is no use for the K-9 cruiser or dog.

### **4. Method of disposition.**

Sell to Madison County Sheriff's Department for \$31,000.

## **Section 3.0 – Provisions Severable**

The provisions of this municipal order are severable; and the invalidity of any provision hereof shall not affect the validity of any other provision thereof; and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

#### **Section 4.0 – Conflicting Municipal Orders Repealed**

All municipal orders or parts of municipal orders in conflict with the provisions of this municipal order are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

#### **Section 5.0 – Effective Date**
