A RESOLUTION CREATING THE POSITION OF DEPUTY CITY CLERK AND DEPUTY CITY TREASURER DUE TO THE ILLNESS, HOSPITALIZATION AND DISABILITY OF THE APPOINTED CITY CLERK AND CITY TREASURER, MABEL BAIRD, WHO HAS FAITH-FULLY AND LOYALLY SERVED THE CITY IN THIS DUAL CAPACITY FOR THIRTEEN YEARS, ESTABLISHING THE DUTIES OF THE DEPUTY CITY CLERK AND CITY TREASURER, AND APPOINTING ANNA BREEDEN DEPUTY CITY CLERK AND CITY TREASURER

WHEREAS The City Clerk and City Treasurer Mabel Baird has on many past occasions advised the City Council that she needs additional help to carry out her assigned tasks, and

WHEREAS The present incapacity of Mabel Baird due to illness has demonstrated vividly to Council the need for a full time City Clerk who needs additional help upon occasion, and

WHEREAS Mabel Baird has faithfully and loyally served the City of Dry Ridge for thirteen years in the dual capacity of city clerk and city treasurer, but is temporarily unable to fulfill the duties of this combined office, although hopefully when she recovers she will return to continue to serve the City, and

WHEREAS The City needs a full time clerk and treasurer during Mabel Baird's absence,

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRY RIDGE DOES RESOLVE:

- l. The dual position of Deputy City Clerk and City Treasurer is hereby created, and the Deputy shall have the same powers and duties, and be under the same bonds, \$1,000.00 as a Notary, \$10,000.00 to the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and \$20,000.00 to the Farmers Home Administration.
 - 2. The salary for this position shall be \$110.00 per week.
- 3. The Deputy City Clerk and City Treasurer shall be employed as a full time employee until Mabel Baird is able to resume the duties of this combined office.

4. Following Mabel Baird's return to her office, the position of Deputy City Clerk and City Treasurer shall become a part-time position, the Council not guaranteeing that there will be any certain number of hours per week or per month that the Deputy Clerk may work.
